

# **Level 3 Newsletter Term 2, 2021**

Welcome to our Term 2 newsletter. You will find information about many of the activities that are happening in Level 3.

### **Homework & Spelling**

The homework grid has been updated and will be posted each Monday on Seesaw. Please encourage your child to complete their homework each night. If you're looking for additional homework activities your child has his or her own personal login to www.mathletics.com.au as well as www.readingeggs.com.au and many children are already working through activities on this site at home.

For spelling this year, we will focus on a different sound each week and will be assessing the students' understanding of these sounds with a spelling test. Students will have a pre-test on Monday and a post-test on Friday. We value your support with this by talking to your child about the sound they are focussing on and even brainstorming words with them, possibly over dinner or on a drive.

**Integrated Topic:** This term in Level 3, our STEM inquiry is called 'Design a Garden.' Students will be researching and designing a garden for the Rangeview schoolyard. They will then be creating a model of their garden design. Our second unit is 'Day and Night.' Students will be investigating the movement of the Earth and Sun to create day and night.

**iPads:** Please ensure your child's iPad is at school every day as they are used at many different times within the school week. Please check to ensure that iPads are fully charged and that the required Apps are installed. It would be great if all students could have a pair of headphones stored at school. We hope you have been enjoying the posts added to Seesaw by students and teachers. This is a great way for you to connect with your child around the learning they are doing at school. If you have not connected to Seesaw or require a new QR code, please speak to your child's teacher. Seesaw will be used in conjunction with Portfolios this semester.

#### **NAPLAN:**

NAPLAN testing begins in week 4, 11<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> May. All classes are currently becoming familiar with and preparing to sit the tests so students won't be overwhelmed on the day. Please speak to your child's teacher if you have any questions.

#### Flora & Fauna:

The Flora & Fauna program will continue to run on Tuesdays throughout the term. At this stage, we are able to have parents back on site to assist with the running of the program. If you or someone in your family is keen to help out in the cooking program, please complete the cooking availability form. If you would like to assist for either Garden Harvest or Maintenance, please meet between the north and south buildings (near the wheel of favours) at 11:30am. There are no restrictions on parent helpers out in the school grounds. All helpers are required to sign in at the office and carry a mask at all times.
